

MANGO CROP REPORT

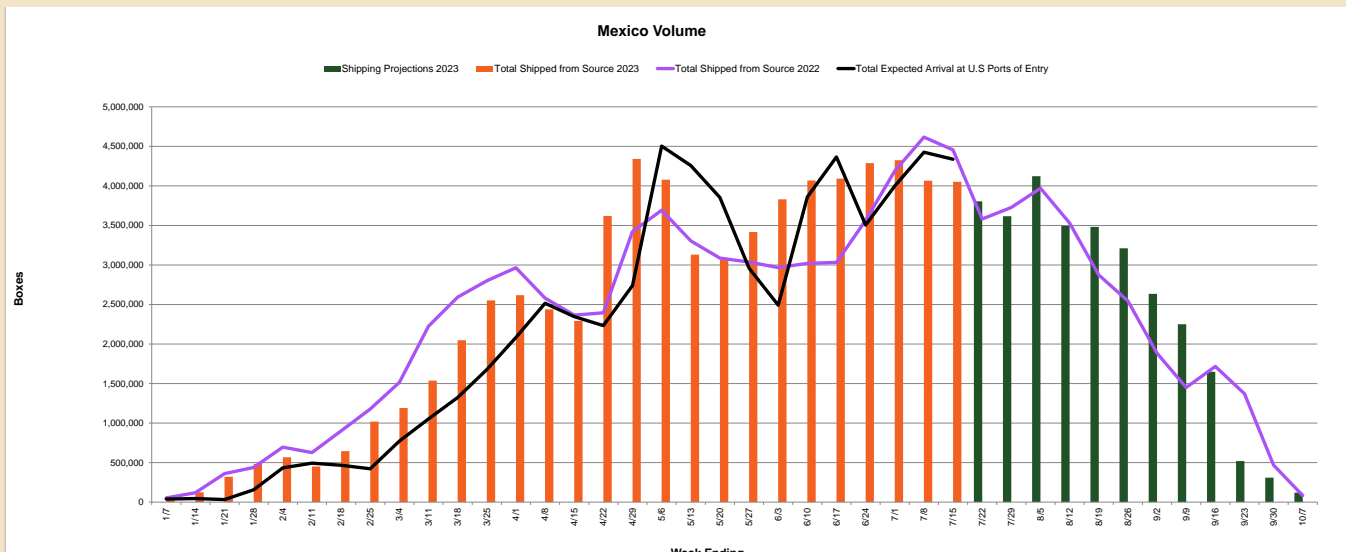
Updated July 21, 2023

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The National Mango Board (NMB) publishes the Mango Crop Report on a regular basis using information from industry organizations and other sources in an effort to provide the best available information on shipment projections, actual arrivals, variety and size availability, and other figures considered useful to the U.S. mango market. Although this information is updated regularly, changes can occur due to numerous factors at any given moment in time. Accordingly, the Mango Crop Report should only be used as a guide.

SUMMARY: Mexico

- ♦ **EXPORTING REGIONS:** Mexico (Sinaloa, Nayarit, North Sinaloa, Michoacan and Jalisco) is currently harvesting and/or packing. See pages 2-4 respectively for more details.
- ♦ **VARIETIES:** There are currently TWO main mango varieties shipped to the US market: Kent (70%) and Ataulfo/Honey (21%). There are also limited supply of Tommy Atkins, Keitt, Thai, Mallika, Manila, Haden, Nam Doc Mai and 2012. See page 2.
- ♦ **SIZING:** (Ataulfo/Honey: Large = size 16 and larger, Small = size 18 and smaller. Round mangos: Extra Large = 7 and larger, Large = sizes 8 and 10, Small = 12 and smaller.)
 - **Mexico (EMEX - Season average):** 55% of Ataulfo/Honey are Large and 45% are Small; 23% of Tommy Atkins are Extra Large, 57% are Large and 20% are Small; 34% of Kent are Extra Large, 56% are Large and 10% are Small. See tables on page 4.
 - **Mexico (North Sinaloa):** 44% of Ataulfo/Honey are Large and 56% are Small. 29% of Tommy Atkins are Extra Large, 63% are Large and 8% are Small; 29% of Kent are Extra Large, 61% are Large and 10% are Small; 100% of Keitt are Small. See tables on page 4.
- ♦ **RECENT VOLUMES:** Total mango volume shipped on week ending 7/15/2023 was approximately **4,051,616 boxes**.
 - ◇ **Mexico:** Volume shipped was approximately **4,051,616 boxes** for a total of 68,688,756 boxes for the season
- ♦ **FUTURE VOLUMES:** Overall mango volume shipped from week 29 (7/22/2023) to week 36 (9/9/2023) is expected to be about **13% Higher YOY**, with arrivals expected from week 30 to 37. The 2023 Mexican season is expected to be about 5% higher YOY. See page 3 for total and weekly volumes.



Please note: U.S. entry ports report incoming volume on different schedules; some report daily and some weekly. This causes discrepancies between the volume shipped from the source and the volume arrived at the U.S. entry ports in any given week.

Projections are adjusted throughout the season as new information is received.

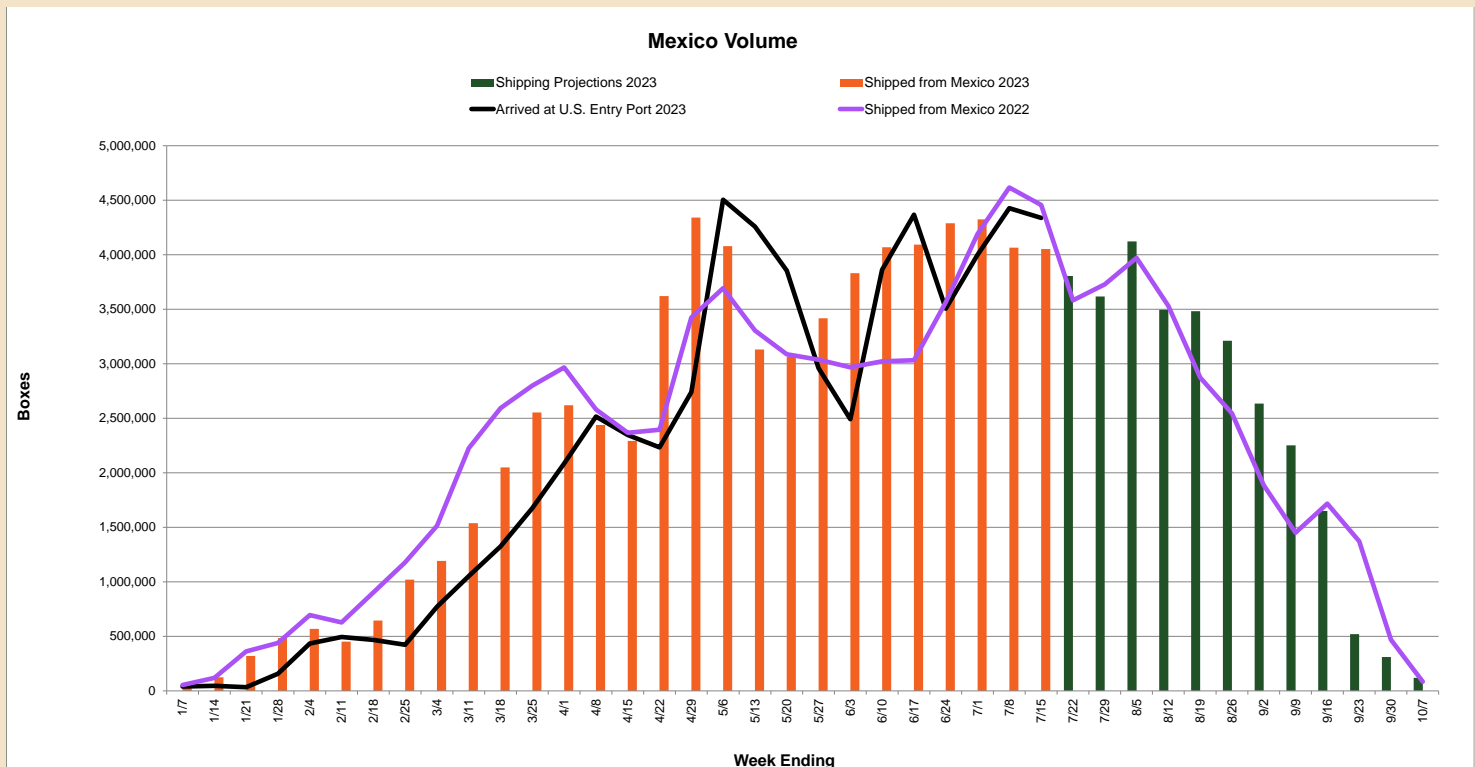
Mexico Crop Information

- The Mexican mango season began the first week of January and will run until the first week of October with a projection of approximately **97** million boxes.
- Last season Mexico's main varieties were: Tommy Atkins (34%), Ataulfo/Honey (27%), Kent (25%), Keitt (11%) and Others (3%)

Volume on week ending 7/15/2023

- Volume shipped from Mexico was approximately **4,051,616** boxes for a total of **68,688,756** boxes for the season
(Sinaloa: 48% - Nayarit: 26% - North Sinaloa: 20% - Michoacan: 4% - Jalisco: 2%)
During the same week last year, volume shipped from Mexico was 4,454,963 boxes for a total of 66,203,557 boxes.

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Price per Box (\$) – By Fruit Size



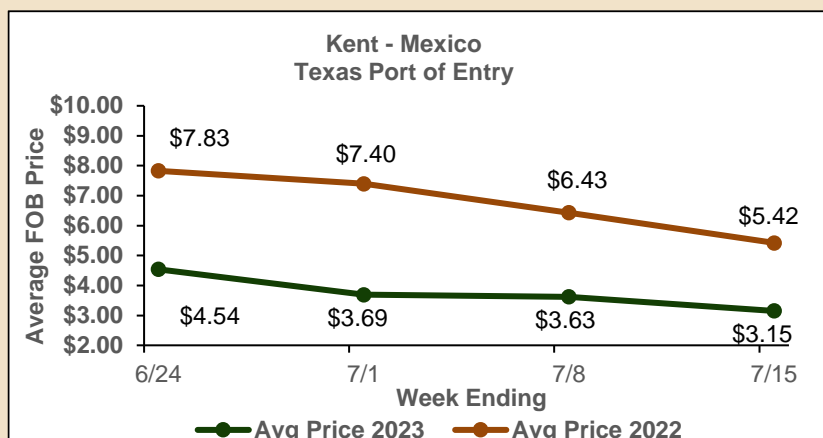
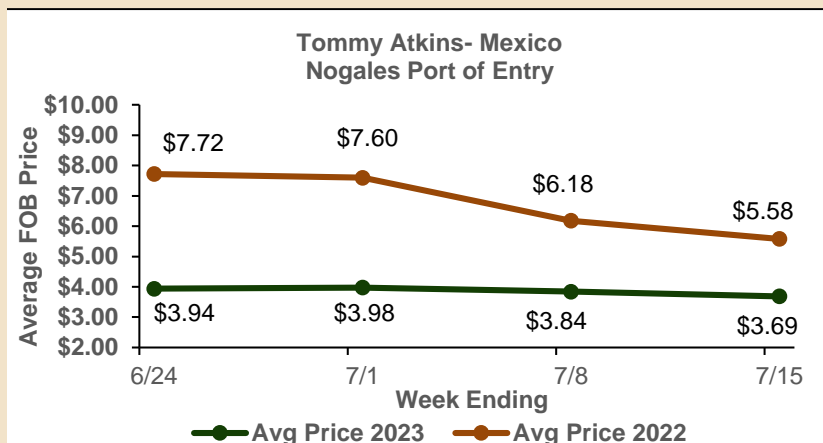
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Crop Report Tools and Resources
